

When we came to government, we had an ambitious agenda to significantly improve the Housing Trust and we have delivered.


We have built more than 1000 new homes, achieving the first significant net increase to South Australian public housing stock in a generation.

# 200 SUPPORTED ACCOMMODATION PLACES

A small minority of public housing tenants require additional support to live safe, healthy and connected lives.

The supported accommodation model ensures that individuals with complex needs, who find it difficult to integrate into suburban neighbourhoods, receive wrap-around services to prevent anti-social behaviour.

**This is why the Malinauskas Labor Government will take to the election a fresh approach to those tenants who need help the most, delivering 200 new supported accommodation places.**

Offering support where someone lives can make all the difference - keeping our communities safe and supporting the wellbeing of Housing Trust tenants.

# 300 MAJOR PUBLIC HOUSING RENOVATIONS

**The Malinauskas Labor Government will take to the election a plan to conduct major renovations to 300 vacant Housing Trust properties to bring them back into stock so they can be tenanted.**

Restoring and renewing these vital public assets with major upgrades to bathrooms, kitchens and living areas, will give more housing options for those who need it the most, like the residents of Bentzen Court.

This commitment will further build on the government's achievements under the Public Housing Improvement Program that saw 350 houses upgraded, modernised and made available to families over the last four years.
